Community Legal Aid has partnered with the Trumbull County Bar Association and seven local Trumbull County courts to meet the need of low-income residents facing housing and financially related legal issues.

Applicants do not need to have a pending legal action to qualify. If you live in Trumbull County and have concerns over housing or debt related issues, or if you are facing an eviction, foreclosure, or consumer/collection lawsuit in a Trumbull County Court, you are encouraged to apply.
